No.A.12032/1/2022-MPSC (DR): Pursuant to No.A.32013/2/2023-P&AR (GSW) dt. 1/4/25 and in supersession of the Guidelines for Conduct of Examinations for direct recruitment to services/posts falling under the purview of the Mizoram Public Service Commission and previous Notification of even No. dated 9/7/24, the Mizoram Public Service Commission hereby prescribes the under mentioned syllabuses – one for General Competitive Examinations and the other for Technical Competitive Examinations in respect of recruitment to Group 'B' Non-Gazetted Posts under the Government of Mizoram.

1. GENERAL COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION

General Competitive Examination shall be held when recruitment for a certain post does not have a specific guideline or when it does not require specific subject wise specification but can be written by any graduate from a recognised university. As far as practicable, the questions shall be of multiple choice (objective type).

The examination shall comprise of the following papers:

1) Paper – I : General English : 100 Marks (3 hours) (Conventional Type & MCQ with negative marking)

2) Paper – II: General Knowledge & Reasoning : 200 Marks (2 hours)

(MCQ with negative marking)

Total of Written Examination : 300 Marks
3) Personal Interview : 40 Marks

Total : 340 Marks

4) Technical Subject Paper-II (MCQ with negative marking) :200 Marks (2 hours)

The syllabus of technical papers and the standard shall be based on the Recruitment / Service / Examination Rules / Regulations of the said posts. If there is no separate prescribed syllabus, the concerned department shall prepare and notify the syllabus duly approved by the Government of Mizoram in the DP&AR (GSW) in consultation with the Commission.

Notes regarding Negative Marking:

- 1) There will be penalty (negative marking) for every wrong answer given by a candidate in the MCQ type questions.
- 2) For each question for which a wrong answer has been given by the candidate, one third of the marks assigned to that question will be deducted as penalty.
- 3) If a candidate gives more than one answer to one question, it will be treated as wrong answer even if any one of the given answers happens to be correct and there will be same penalty as above for that question.
- 4) If any question is left blank, i.e. no answer is given by the candidate, there will be no penalty for that question.

Consequently, these syllabuses shall be inserted in the Schedule-I of the Mizoram Public Service Commission (Conduct of Examinations) Guidelines in conformity with para 14(2) of the Guidelines ibid.
