In case, the response is more, NFC reserves the right to restrict the number of candidates to be called for personal interview by conducting a Screening Test. The decision of NFC will be final and binding. <u>Method of Screening Test :</u> 1. 75 multiple choice questions with negative marking. 2. Three (03) marks will be awarded for correct answer and 1 mark will be deducted for incorrect answer. 3. Duration of examination will be 90 minutes.						
12602, 12605 and 12606	The Process of selection involves three stages i.e., Stage 1 – Preliminary Test, Stage 2 – Advanced Test Stage 3 – Skill Test. In the event of a tie, the following criteria shall be adopted in sequence for deciding position in merit list: - Candidate with lower negative Marks in Stage-2 to be placed higher on the merit list. - Candidate with higher marks in Stage-1 to be placed higher on the merit list. - Candidate with lower negative Marks in Stage-1 to be placed higher on the merit list. - Candidate with higher positive marks in Mathematics in Stage-1 is placed higher. - Candidate with higher positive marks in Science in Stage-1 is placed higher. <u>Stage 3 –Skill Test</u> - Based on the merit list prepared after Stage-2, candidates in each post will be shortlisted for Skill Test. - The number of candidates shortlisted for Skill Test would depend upon the number of candidates qualifying in Stage-2 but shall not exceed 5 times the number of vacancies for the post. - The Skill Test will be conducted on a “Go / No-Go” basis for qualifying the candidate. 6.3	Candidates are required to apply for the post online only. No other means / mode of application will be accepted.
6.4	Candidates who have not acquired the mandatory / requisite educational qualifications as on the last date of submission of online application need not apply. No correspondence or clarification will be entertained on this matter.
6.5	Candidates should read the instructions in the advertisement and online application form carefully before making any entry or selecting any option.
6.6	One application only should be submitted for one post. Candidates should submit separate application for each post, if they are eligible and intend to apply for more than one post.

6.9	Upload latest (front-facing) passport size colour photograph with white background. Photo should be of size 165 x 125 pixels in jpg / jpeg format and should not exceed 50 KB and signature should be of size 80 x 125 pixels in jpg / jpeg format and should not exceed 20 KB.
6.10	Candidates must ensure that their photo and signature is clearly visible in preview at the time of filling of application in online mode. If photo / signature displayed is small or not visible in preview on website, the application will be rejected. Therefore, candidates must ensure that photo and signature are clearly visible.

8. CENTRES OF EXAMINATION :

8.1	Examinations / Tests are tentatively scheduled to be conducted in specified cities viz., Hyderabad, Telangana; Mumbai, Maharashtra; Rawatbhata, Rajasthan; and Pazhayakayal, Tamil Nadu. These examination centers are only indicative and not final. Though efforts will be made to conduct examination in the above specified cities, candidates may be required to appear for examination / Tests at a place other than the above mentioned places.
8.2	Candidates may indicate their choice of city (nearer to their present address) in their application form in the order of preference. Allocation of centers will be decided based on the number of candidates registering for each city. However, NFC reserves the right to add or delete centre(s) without assigning any reason. Note: Schedule for Screening Test (if required), Personal Interview, Skill Test will be notified on NFC website https://www.nfc.gov.in. Therefore, candidates are advised to visit the website frequently for any updates.

9. ADMISSION TO EXAMINATION / INTERVIEW :

9.1	Admit Card will be sent to the registered e-mail ID of the candidate and SMS alert will also be sent to the registered mobile number.
9.2	Admit card consists of (i) Candidate copy and (ii) NFC copy. Candidate has to affix latest colour photograph on both copies of Admit card and bring to the Examination Hall. In addition to the Admit Card, it is mandatory to carry any one of the following Original valid Photo-ID with date of birth: (a) Aadhaar Card/ E-Aadhaar (b) Voter ID Card (c) Driving License (d) PAN Card (e) Passport (f) Employer ID Card (Government / PSU) (g) Ex-Serviceman Discharge Book issued by Ministry of Defence (h) Any other photo bearing ID Card issued by the Central / State Government.
9.3	Candidates working under the Central / State Government / Public Sector Undertakings / Autonomous bodies, if called for Interview / Skill Test should submit a "NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE" (NOC) from their employer. If candidates fail to submit NOC at the time of Interview / Skill Test, they will not be allowed to appear for the Interview / Skill Test.

10. DOCUMENT VERIFICATION (DV) :

10.1	Document verification will be carried out prior to Interview (for post codes 12601, 12603 & 12604) and Skill Test (for post codes 12602, 12605 & 12606). Candidates are required to produce all the relevant following certificates along with two sets of self-attested photocopies of certificates and a copy of online application. i) Educational qualifications supported by appropriate mark sheets / certificates (all in original) as proof of possessing the minimum educational qualification as on the closing date of online application. ii) Valid proof of Date of birth (Matriculation / Secondary School Certificate). iii) Caste certificate in respect of SC/ST candidates issued by designated authority in the prescribed format and the community should have been included in the Presidential orders in relation to the concerned State of domicile as per the format given in Annexure-B.
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	iv) Caste certificate in respect of OBC candidates should be issued by an authorized Authority in the prescribed format with non-creamy layer certification as per the format given in Annexure-C and the caste / community should have been included in the Central lists of Other Backward Caste. The crucial date for determining the OBC non-creamy layer certificate will be the closing date of online application. v) OBC for the purpose of AGE RELAXATION AND RESERVATION means “persons of OBC categories not belonging to the Creamy Layer” as defined in Government of India, Department of Personnel & Training OM No.36012/22/93-Estt.(SCT) dated 08.09.93 and as amended from time to time. vi) Candidates who are not covered under the scheme of reservation for SC / ST / OBC and whose family gross annual income is below Rs.8 Lakh (Rupees Eight Lakh), are identified as EWS against posts reserved for EWS. Income shall also include income from all sources i.e., salary, agriculture, business, profession etc. for the financial year prior to the year of application (2024-25) in accordance with DoPT OM No. 36039/1/2019-Estt.(Res) dated 31/01/2019, 11/06/2019 and No.43011/11/2022-Estt.(Res-II) dated 19/09/2022. The Income and Asset Certificate issued in the prescribed format as given in Annexure-D shall only be accepted as proof of candidate's claim as belonging to EWS. Candidates who fail to bring the requisite certificates shall not be allowed for Interview / Skill Test.
10.2	Disability Certificate in respect of PwD candidates issued by an appropriate authority regarding physical disability (as per the formats given in Annexure E & F - applicable only for Persons with Disability) shall be as under: i) According to the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Rules, 1996 notified on 31/12/1996 by the Central Government in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) and (2) of Section 73 of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 (1 of 1996)], a disability certificate shall be issued by a Medical Board duly constituted by the Central or a State Government. ii) The certificate would be valid for a period of 5 years for those whose disability is temporary. The Medical Board shall indicate the period of validity of the certificate where there are chances of variation in the degree of disability. For those who acquired permanent disability, the validity can be shown as permanent. On representation by the applicant, the Medical Board may review its decision having regard to all the facts and circumstances of the case and pass such orders in the matter as it thinks fit.
10.3	Candidates with benchmark disabilities desiring to have facility of a Scribe in the Stage-1 and Stage-2 written test for the Post Codes 12602 and 12605 will have to indicate the same in the online application. Facility of Scribe will be made available to the desiring candidates as per the Government orders in this regard.
10.4	Engagement of Scribe will be subject to the following conditions: i) A compensatory time of 20 minutes per hour of examination will be provided to the Persons with Benchmark Disability utilizing the facility of Scribe. ii) No attendant other than the Scribe for eligible candidates will be allowed inside the Examination Hall. iii) The PwBD candidates who require the facility of Scribe must produce relevant documents at the time written examination as in the format given in Annexure-G. Candidate who fails to produce certificate as in Annexure-G will not be allowed the facility of Scribe.
10.5	Those SC/ST/OBC persons with disabilities selected on their own merit without relaxed standards along with other candidates will be considered against unreserved vacancies provided the post is identified for persons with disability of relevant category (as applicable).
10.6	A candidate who claims change in name after Matriculation or due to marriage (except change in surname) should submit Gazette notification for changing the name.

11. ACTION AGAINST CANDIDATES FOUND INDULGING IN MALPRACTICE :

If any candidate is found to have indulged in any malpractices at any stage, candidature of such candidate will be cancelled and NFC may also report the matter to Police/ Investigating Agencies, as deemed fit.

12. COURT'S JURISDICTION :

Any dispute with regard to this recruitment will be subject to the Courts having jurisdiction in Hyderabad only and in case of any dispute, English version of detailed advertisement hosted on NFC website <https://www.nfc.gov.in> shall be final.

13. GENERAL CONDITIONS :

13.1	The candidate must be a Citizen of India.
13.2	PwBD candidates with OL and HH disability can submit application for the Post code 12602 and candidates with OA, OL, HH disability can submit application for the post code 12605, which are identified suitable for PwBD.
13.3	The vacancies are provisional and subject to variation. NFC reserves the right to fill up the post or even to cancel / restrict/ modify / alter the whole process of recruitment without issuing any further notice or assigning any reason thereof.
13.4	Question paper for written examination / test will be in English and Hindi language.
13.5	The eligibility criteria including age, educational qualifications and period of experience as prescribed in the advertisement will be determined with reference to the last date of submission of online application.
13.6	All the qualifications acquired by the candidate should be recognized by the concerned Regulatory Authorities in India.
13.7	SC/ST outstation candidates called for Tests / Interview / Skill Test (as applicable) will be paid to and for travelling allowance of Sleeper class / Second-class railway fare by the shortest route (subject to production of tickets) as per Rules, provided the fare of first 30 kms (rail or road) shall be borne by the candidates. However, Travelling Allowance is not admissible to those SC/ST candidates who are already in Central/State Government services, Central/State Government Corporation, Public Sector Undertakings, Local Government Institutions and Panchayats and the concession availed from Railways, if any. 13.8	Selected candidates are liable to serve in any part of India in any constituent unit of the Department of Atomic Energy.
13.9	The nature of duties to be performed by the candidates on appointment may involve working in round-the-clock shifts in operational plants and areas.
13.10	Upon appointment, the candidates will be governed by the National Pension System as notified by Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, Government of India vide Notification No.F.No.5/7/2003-ECB & PR dated 22-12-2003 or Unified Pension Scheme under the National Pension System as notified by Ministry of Finance, Government of India vide notification No. F.No. FX-1/3/2024-PR dated 24.01.2025 as amended from time to time.

13.11	In case, the Universities / Boards award letter grades/CGPA/OGPA/SGPA, etc., the candidate has to indicate equivalent percentage of marks as per the norms adopted by the University / Board concerned. In the absence of the same, the candidature will not be considered.
13.12	Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/EWS category should clearly indicate their category in the application (even when applying for UR vacancy) and should furnish proof of their category in the specified format at the time of Document verification.

13.16	Any amendment / information relating to this recruitment shall be made available only on the website https://www.nfc.gov.in . Information displayed on the website shall be deemed as intimation to the candidates. Hence, candidates must regularly check the website for updates, if any.

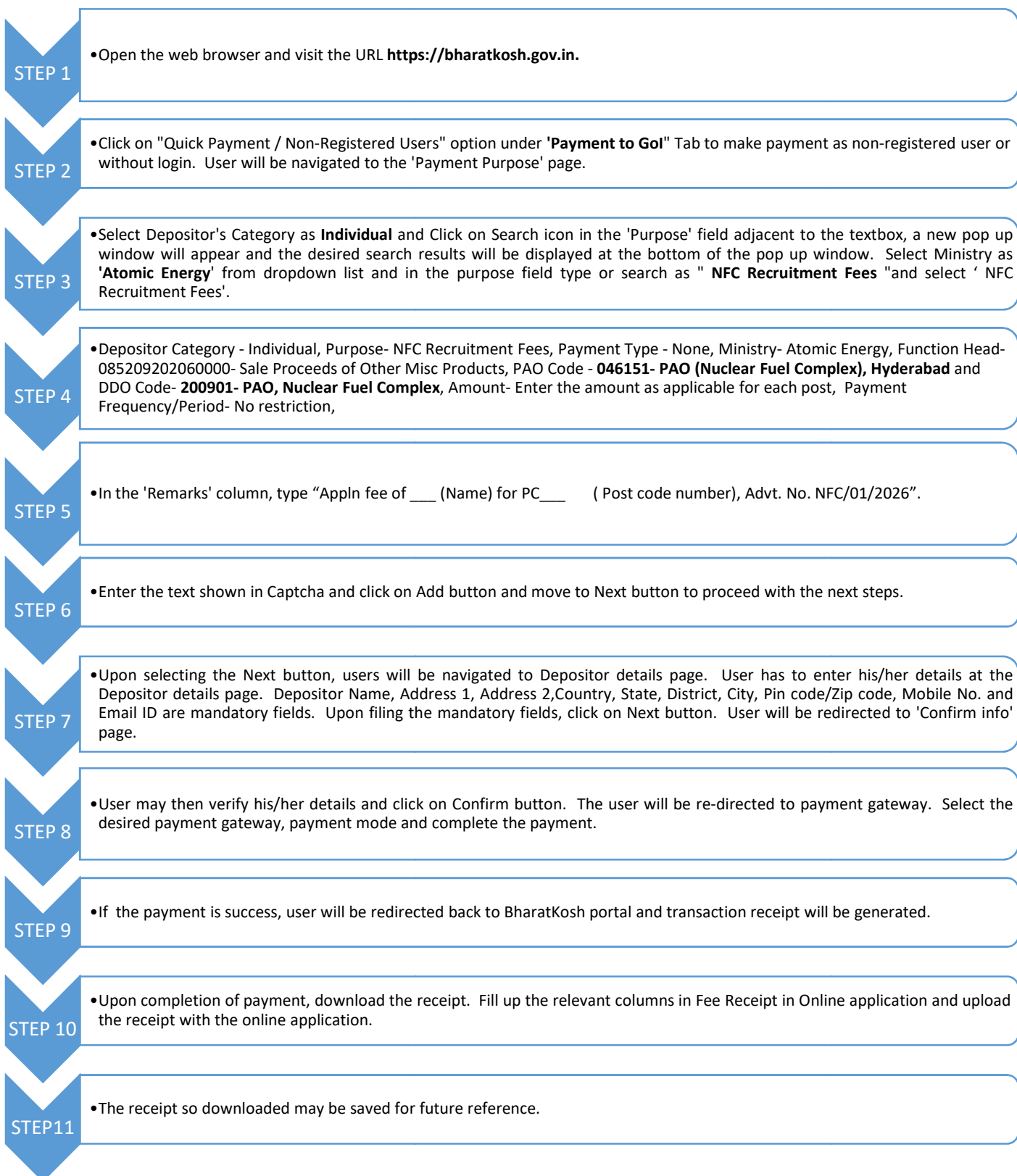
